1- BASICS OF ISLAM:

Who made us? Allah made us.

Who is Allah? Allah is our creator. He is the creator of everything.

Does Allah have a father or a mother? No, Allah has no father or mother.

Does Allah have any sons or daughters? No, Allah has no sons or daughters.

Can you hide anything from Allah? No. Allah is well aware of everything we do.

2- What do we have to do to please Allah

- Pray 5 times daily.
- Respect our parents.
- Always remember Allah.
- Read the Quran.
- Help the needy.
- Be kind to everyone, including animals.
- Always keep promises.

3- What are the pillars of Islam?

- Testifying that there is no god but Allah and the Prophet Muhammad was his messenger
- Establish 5 daily prayers; Fajr-2, Dhuhr-4, Asr-4, Maghrib-3, Isha-4
- Zakah to pay (2.5 percent of your wealth to the poor)
- fasting the month of Ramadhan
- Hajj, Pilgrimage to Mekka at least once in the life time

4- What are the pillars of Iman?

To believe in Allah, His angels, His Books, His messengers, day of judgment , and the Qadar good and bad.

5- What are the 4 holy books that Allah sent down?

- Al Quran : Given to Prophet Muhammad (The seal to Prophet hood)
- Torah : Given to Prophet Musa (Moses)
- Injeel (Gospel) : Given to Prophet Iesa (Jesus)

➤ Zaboor (Psalms) : Given to Prophet Daud (David)

6- What are the main sources of the Sharia Law?

Quran and Sunnah

7- What is the difference between Al Quran and Al Hadeeth?

- Al Quran is the exact speech of Allah that was sent down upon His prophet Muhammed ﷺ, beginning with Surat Al-Fatiha (The Opening) and ending with Surat An'Naas (The Mankind)
- Everything related and reported from the prophet including his sayings, actions, confirmation and attributes inspired by Allah

8- How Many Juza, Hezb, Surahs and Ayahs are in the Quran?

30 Juza, 60 Hezb, 114 Surahs and 6236 or 6666 Ayahs in the Quran

9- Complete the Hadeeth: (No –religious- journey is to be undertaken except)

"No –religious- journey is to be undertaken except to -pray in- the three mosques: The Sacred Mosque (Makkah), the Aqsa Mosque (Jerusalem), and this Mosque of mine (al-Madinah)"

10-What are the steps of wudua?

- Intention
- Saying bismillah
- Washing hands until wrist 3 times
- Rinsing mouth 3 times
- Inhalation/cleaning nose 3 times
- Washing face 3 times
- Washing hands until elbows 3 times
- Wiping head one time
- Wiping ears one time
- Washing feet 3 times

11-What acts invalidate wudu?

Passing wind, Deep sleep and Using the bathroom

12-What should you do if you forget to pray or miss a prayer because of oversleeping?

Pray it as soon as you remember it

13-Name the father, mother, grandfather, uncle, wet nurse and first wife of the Prophet?

His father is Abdullah, mother is Amena, grandfather Abdulmutaleb, uncle is Abu Talib, wet nurse is Halema and first wife is Khadija

14- Who are the 10 companions promised Jannah?

Umar ibn al-Khattab, Uthman bin Affan, Ali bin Abe Talib, Talha Ibn Ubaidullah, Zubair Ibn Al-Awwam, Abdur Rahman Ibn Auf, Sa'd Ibn Abi Waqqas, Saeed Ibn Zayd, and Abu Ubaida ibn Al-Jarrah.

15- Mention 6 optional acts (Sunnah) and etiquettes of Fasting/Sawm?

- Breaking the fast as soon as the sunsets and delay one's breakfast
- Delaying Suhoor (last meal before dawn) to the end of the night and just before dawn.
- To break one's fast on dates or water
- To recite the Holy Quran a lot
- To maintain Taraweeh prayer after Isha
- To say "I'm fasting" and not respond or retaliate to anyone who argues or curses you

16- What are the 12 Islamic months in order?

Muḥarram, Şafar, Rabī' al-Awwal, Rabī' al-Thānī, Jumādā al-Awwal, Jumādā al-Thānī, Rajab, Sha' bān, Ramaḍān, Shawwāl, Dhū al-Qa' dah, and Dhū al-Ḥijjah.

17- What are the guidelines for Gender Relations in Islam?

- Allah is with you and he's aware of what you do
- Lower your gaze.
- Keep it public.

- Protect your reputation.
- No touching.
- Be respectful of people's personal space and levels of comfort
- Speak in a decent manner.
